- MUST HAVE A VALID OREGON DRIVER'S LICENSE.
- MUST MEET COLUMBIA RIVER FIRE AND RESCUE PHYSICAL QUALIFICATIONS AND PASS A BACKGROUND CHECK, MEDICAL AND PSYCHOLOGICAL EXAMS, AND DRUG SCREEN PRIOR TO APPOINTMENT.

  REGULATIONS OF THE STATE OF OREGON, COLUMBIA RIVER FIRE AND RESCUE STANDARD OPERATING GUIDELINES,
  COLUMBIA COUNTY, OREGON ASA PLAN AND THE COLUMBIA RIVER FIRE AND RESCUE PERSONNEL POLICIES.
- THIS POSITION WILL NORMALLY WORK 4 ON 4 OFF, 12 HOUR SHIFTS ASSIGNED TO THE AMBULANCE. SCHEDULED HOURS
  MAY VARY, AND CHANGE BASED ON THE NEEDS OF THE DISTRICT.
- TRANSPORT PATIENTS 30- 40MINUTES TO THE APPROPRIATE HOSPITAL
